Parallel Slalom 'Showdown'

On Saturday evening 18:00-19:00 Stafford and Stone CC will be organising a Parallel slalom 'Showdown', as an entertainment spectacle. There will be a **one run qualification** process **open to all Premier paddlers** from 16:30-17:45, first come first served, from K1M, K1W, C1M, C1W, C2. The fastest 4 in each category will go into the head-to-head Parallel Semi-finals starting at 18:00-19:00 on Saturday Evening. Thus for the remaining Premier Paddlers and Div1's this will be an excellent event to watch. The parallel slalom 'showdown' will be run on the top section of the course, leaving the Div1 course available for practice at this time too.

We'll be starting the Finals promptly at 18:00, so don't be late!!

This does <u>not</u> include Saturday 'paddling-up' entrants. But <u>no</u> 'paddling-up' competitors will progress from the Saturday qualification round, regardless of their result, (as the Semi-final result is unnecessary in their process) Hence they are free to enter the Sunday Div1 as usual.
