Emergency Operating Procedures

The following procedures should be carried out in case of an emergency.

Familiarise yourself with all emergency procedures and where the emergency exists, marshalling areas, first aid equipment and telephones are.

Fire: In case of a fire, evacuate / leave the building immediately by the designated emergency exits and do not re-enter the building under any circumstances until advised by the emergency services.

Go to the marshalling area at the double gates along the canal from the club house and report to a club official, coach or responsible person.

Call the emergency services straight away using either a mobile phone or the land line situated at the Queens Head Public House.

Serious Accident / Incident

In case of a serious accident / incident, where possible stay with the injured person(s) removing them from any danger, but making sure you do not put either yourself or others at risk or danger in doing so and apply First Aid.

Call the emergency services as quickly as possible, either yourself or by asking someone else to contact them by using a mobile phone or by using the land line at the Queens Head Public House (opposite)
